ABOUT THE ROLE

Gould League are looking for a part-time volunteer with a passion for or experience in photography and videography to build out photo library and help us develop new videos to showcase our work. These help us obtain grants, as well as inform schools and community groups about the services we provide.

The role requires adhoc attendance at our programs and or special events. Some days may only require 1 hour – but others will require a half or full day. The work will be spread across our 4 sites (Sustainability Education Centre at Cheltenham, Ricketts Point Marine Sanctuary; Toolangi State Forest; Cardinia Flora and Fauna Reserve) with occasional work in childcare centres/schools and or at special events. A nominal travel allowance will be made for Toolangi and Cardinia sites and other remote locations.

Tasks include but are not limited to:

- Taking photos and or videos of programs, keynote addresses at conferences and or our involvement at special events.
- Taking drone footage (drone can be provided)
- Making short videos
- Seeking permissions where relevant at public events (we obtain permission from Schools /Councils

 but public events will need special permission forms to be completed by members of the public if filmed or photographed.)
- Understanding the need for privacy of some students/teachers so filming may be of back of students. Alternatively, we may need to blur faces.

YOU WILL NEED TO HAVE

- A passion for the environment, conservation and education for sustainability.
- An ability to work independently and as a team, either remotely or face to face.
- A warm and enthusiastic personality and open communication skills.
- Access to a computer and relevant programs.
- Passion for working with community groups and/ or not for profit.
- Good verbal and written communication skills able to engage stakeholders.
- Your own equipment camera/s, tripods. (Drone not necessary but preferred).
- Willingness to share photos and unlimited copyright and use of images/video provided to Gould League.
- Experience in editing including blurring of faces if no approvals are given.

- A current Working with Children's Check or VIT as Working with Children's Check as our Sustainability Centre hosts excursions with school children. Volunteer Working with Children Checks available at no charge.
- Would suit retired photographer/videographer or student seeking relevant experience.
- This role requires flexibility of days and or hours as programs and or special events are not on set days. Minimum commitment of 6 months, but preferably 12 months.
