ABOUT THE ROLE

We are looking for a very hands on creative person with experience in sewing, arts and crafts to help maintain our props and costumes, and make new one's as we expand our service offerings. Some of the program props we have a quite old and are now quite delicate, so someone with experience working with a wide array of materials to help us maintain them is what we are after. We don't expect you will be able to address all our needs, but having experience in a wide range of arts and crafts would be advantageous.

Current items requiring assistance include:

- Entrance to the Giant Shrinking Machine
- Snails and worms on the wall in the Giant Compost Bin
- Blankets for our Worm Farms
- Replication of costumes butterflies, worms, ladybugs etc.
- Making replicas of bauxite rocks
- Making replicas of rocks for frog pond and lizard lounge
- Making and installing new perches to showcase birds and other wildlife at Cheltenham and Toolangi
- Making stands to display historical artifacts
- Repairing stands for taxidermied species and damaged face of our taxidermy emu.
- Rehanging of bees in our Drama Room
