Gould League are well known for its environmental posters, books and badges. We are looking to expand our profile and grow our revenue streams by selling them at market stalls and special events. We are thus looking for a part-time volunteer to:

- Identify and connect with market stall operators in Greater Melbourne area. *Consideration will be given to large events in country locations across Victoria as GL is well known across the state.*
- Identify and connect with special event operators (these may be council or public event organisers). Gould League will provide contacts of council or other stakeholders we feel can assist in the role.
- Help manage stock levels for sellers (who also work as Environmental Educators for Gould League).
- Present ideas to improve displays/systems to manage stock and rosters.
- Present ideas for new items to be sold.
- Establish risk assessment for market stalls along with operators.
- Establish Operations Manual for Sellers, so they know exactly what is required for the various markets.
- Co-ordinate stock levels and or request orders via online Bookshop Manager / General Manager.
- This role will mostly be online but will require some travel to our offices at our Cheltenham Sustainability Education Centre.
- 4-8 hours a week. Once we are embedded into markets, hours can be reduced. Can be flexible with days and hours.
- Minimum commitment 6 months Preferred commitment more than 6 months.
