About the Role

We're looking for a passionate volunteer photographer and/or videographer to help capture the impact of Gould League's environmental education programs and events.

Your images and videos will help tell our story, support grant applications, promote our programs, and inspire more people to get involved in sustainability and conservation.

This flexible volunteer role involves attending selected programs, excursions and special events throughout the year. Assignments may range from a short one-hour visit to a half or full day, depending on the activity.

A modest travel allowance is available for travel to Toolangi, Cardinia and other remote locations.

What You'll Do

- Photograph and film Gould League programs, events and community activities.
- Capture high-quality images for our marketing, communications and grant applications.
- Create short promotional videos and social media content.
- Capture drone footage where appropriate (drone available if required).
- Assist with basic editing, including image selection, video editing and blurring faces where permissions are not available.
- Follow privacy and consent requirements when photographing children and members of the public.

We're Looking For Someone Who

- Has experience or a strong interest in photography, videography or digital storytelling.
- Is passionate about the environment, sustainability, conservation or education.
- Can work independently and communicate effectively with a range of people.
- Has access to their own camera equipment (drone desirable but not essential).
- Has basic photo and video editing skills.
- Is happy to provide Gould League with ongoing usage rights to images and videos captured in the role.
- Holds a current Working With Children Check (Volunteer WWCC available free of charge) or VIT registration.

Time Commitment

- Flexible and project-based.
- Programs and events occur on various days throughout the year.
- Minimum commitment of 6 months, with 12 months preferred.
